Bring your donations of <u>CASH</u> or wish-list items to the Trunk-or-Treat:

The most needed items for cold and flu season:

- Mucinex 600 and 1200mg (plain and DM, or similar expectorant)
- Delsym syrup (or similar 12-hr cough suppressant)
- Phenylephrine HCL 5mg (Sudafed PE, or similar)

Small packages that can be handed out are best.
